Are You Proudly Wearing Your Colors?

This week starts my favorite time of year. I love this time of year because of two things: college football and hunting season. It does not escape me that there are some who do not enjoy college football. And, I am also aware of the fact that there are some who do not enjoy hunting. However, there are some things that I want to illustrate using these two activities.

First, I want us to look at college football. It is not difficult in the least to see what team a person pulls for. This past Saturday, I was dressed in an Alabama polo shirt and an Alabama baseball cap. It did not take a rocket scientist to determine that I was an Alabama fan. I proudly wore those colors without any hesitation. I wanted people to know that I was a supporter of Alabama football. At the same time, I saw people wearing colors for Auburn, Florida, and even one confused person in Tennessee Orange. Most are proud to do this. My observation is this: are we just as proud to show our devotion to God? Do we hesitate to bow our heads in a public restaurant before we eat? Are we tempted to remain silent when someone puts down the Lord's church, or says something that is scripturally false? In Matthew 5:13-16, Jesus teaches us that we are to let our light shine, or to let our colors show. Can people look at the way we live our lives and know that we are a disciple of Christ? What would happen in the Church if we all had the same passion for God as many do for football? In Acts 11, we find Barnabas and Saul teaching and making disciples in Antioch. In v. 26, we find that that is where the disciples of Christ were first called Christians. This was a name the city gave to them because of the way they lived! Let this be true of us!

Secondly, when I go hunting, I am dressed in head to toe in camouflage. I have my face paint on, all my camo matches, and I am sure to spray down with scent eliminating spray. I do not want the deer to know that I am there at all, and squirrels don't know either! Unfortunately, this is how too many "disciples" live. They wear their spiritual camouflage, so that no one knows that they are a follower of Christ. In Matthew 10:32-33, Jesus tells us something that we need to remember. He tells us that if we are ashamed of Him and do not confess Him before men, then He will not confess us before God. However, if we confess Him before men, then He will confess us before God. Jesus is telling us that we cannot wear spiritual camouflage. People need to know that we are followers of Christ!

Over the next year, we will have many opportunities to let our lights shine in this community. Let us be sure that we are wearing our spiritual colors proudly. May Fort Payne look at us and determine that we are in fact Christians. Just like the city of Antioch did in Acts 11. I look forward to what is ahead for this great congregation!
