What Shall We Do With The Gospel?

In the book of Romans, Paul writes to us about the power and glory of the gospel. The gospel is a message of "glad tidings of good things" (Rom. 10:15). The gospel is the power in which God uses to save (Rom 1:16). This gospel has been "once and for all delivered" (Jude 3). So, what shall we do with this gospel? There are four things that we can do with the gospel of Christ.

We can be ashamed of the gospel. (Rom. 1:16)

Ashamed is defined as "a feeling of shame or disgrace". Why would anyone be ashamed of the gospel? Sometimes the fear of persecution can cause a person to be ashamed of the gospel. Other times it is a desire for social approval that leads to being ashamed of the gospel. To be ashamed of the gospel is to be ashamed of the God, who is the author of it (Rom. 1:1). To be ashamed of the gospel is to be ashamed of Christ, who is the subject of it (Rom. 1:16). To be ashamed of the gospel is to be ashamed of salvation, which is the purpose of it (Rom. 1:16). Being ashamed of the gospel causes a person to apologize when it is preached. Being ashamed causes a person to hesitate on urging people to believe and obey the gospel.

We can pervert the gospel. (Gal. 1:6-9)

A perversion of the commands of the gospel is "denominationalism". The commands of the gospel are clearly revealed in its contents. Mark 16:15-16 tells us that a person must hear the gospel taught, then believe it and be baptized to be saved. To pervert these commands in any way voids the saving power of the gospel. To pervert the gospel in any way is to bring condemnation upon ourselves. To believe a perverted gospel is to bring condemnation upon ourselves (Gal. 1:6-9).

We can preach the gospel. (Rom. 10:13-15)

The first step in the plan of salvation is to hear the gospel preached (Rom. 10:17). This cannot be done unless the gospel message is preached. Before Jesus left this earth, He commanded His apostles to "preach the gospel to creation" (Mark 16:15). Paul commanded Timothy to "commit the things that he had heard to faithful men, that they might be able to teach others" (2 Tim. 2:2). God has placed a great responsibility upon man. If the saving gospel is going to save, then we must be preaching it!

We can obey the gospel. (2 Thess. 1:7-9)

The gospel has facts to be believed and commands to be obeyed. The commands of the gospel are seen in the Great Commission (Matt. 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16). In 2 Thess. 1:7-9, Paul reveals a sobering fact: unless the commands of the gospel are obeyed, man has no hope!! God has made salvation "common" (Jude 3). This means that anyone can obey the gospel and obtain eternal life. So, why would anyone not take advantage of this opportunity?

What will you do with the gospel? Will you be ashamed of it, pervert it, or will you obey it? The decision is solely yours. I pray that you will be able to make the same statement that Paul was able to make: "I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ!"
