Are You Glorifying God?

I grew up, and still am, an Atlanta Braves fan. My dad and I would sit and watch them every chance that we had. My favorite Braves player of all time, Chipper Jones, retired a few seasons ago and he just became a first ballot hall of famer. He will have his bust, career stats, and playing jersey placed into the Cooperstown Museum for future generations to see and appreciate.

There is nothing wrong with making efforts to remember the accomplishments of others, but a question that we need to ask is: *“how do we glorify God?”* God deserves to be glorified more than anyone else because of His sacrifice and love (Romans 5:8). God deserves glory and honor because of His great mercy given to us (Romans 15:9). Here are some ways in which we can glorify God Almighty.

We glorify God by fruitfulness. (John 15:8)

Jesus has told us that we will be known by our fruits (Matthew 7:17-20). If we are bearing good fruit, then the world will know that we are of God. Likewise, if we bear bad fruit or no fruit at all, then all will know that we are of the world. It needs to be remembered that a good tree cannot produce bad fruit and that a bad tree cannot produce good fruit. Are we producing the type of fruit that glorifies God?

We glorify God by our service. (1 Peter 4:11)

James tells us that pure and undefiled religion is to minister to the less fortunate (James 1:27). We are to be imitators of Christ. Christ Himself tells us that He did not come to be ministered unto, but to minister (Mark 10:45). If we are to have the mind of Christ (Phil. 2:5), then we must be serving others. Are we glorifying God by serving others as Christ did?

We glorify God by suffering. (1 Peter 4:14-16)

If we are going to live Godly in this present world, then we will suffer (2 Timothy 3:12). We must not be surprised when it happens! When others criticize us for standing behind the word of God, it means we are glorifying God. This suffering is necessary because it strengthens our faith. James tells us to *“count it all joy”* (James 1:2-4).

Let's be sure that we are glorifying God every day. We must ask ourselves: *“is my life glorifying God?”* If it isn't, then we need to make the necessary changes. There is no other being that deserves the proper honor and glory than God Almighty.
