You People Are Crazy

The following is an excerpt from an article by Eric Lyons from the ***Apologetics Press*** weekly email.

*"I freely admit that I believe a donkey spoke, an iron ax head floated, and a woman turned into a pillar of salt. As certain as I am of my own existence, I am convinced that water flowed from a rock, that a man's severed ear was immediately reattached with the touch of a hand, and that dead people have come back to life. I believe that, not only did a burning bush not really burn up, but also that three men survived a fiery furnace without a single singed hair on their heads. I believe that a man spent three days inside of a sea creature and lived to tell about it.¹ And yes, I believe a virgin gave birth to a Son, Who will one day **"descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord"** (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17).*

Increasingly, more and more of the population of this country actually believe that we are crazy for believing what Bro. Lyons wrote in his article. And I believe that, as time goes on, more and more will share the sentiment that *"you people are crazy"*. You have to wonder how this sentiment has come about mostly in our lifetime.

I can remember in my earlier years that very few people would have uttered those words.
