Redeeming the Time

(Colossians 4:5)

Many times in today's society, most people simply do not "have time" for God. We can easily see this in the Church when it comes to the attendance of worship services, Bible classes, and evangelism. There are many in the brotherhood who have so many extracurricular activities that some things are left out. Sadly, it is the most important thing that falls by the wayside.

Many fail to understand that the Christian is a steward of time. 1 Cor. 4:2 tells us that <u>faithfulness</u> is <u>required</u> of stewards. This means that God expects us to manage the time that we have been given wisely. Can a Christian fully expect to be considered "faithful" by God if they make time for their activities, but are too busy to make time for Him? I am not saying that all the extracurricular activities that we participate in aren't important. What I am saying is that they are not more important than Bible class, worship, or lectureship.

In Col. 4:5, Paul tells us that we must be "redeeming the time." What does this mean? This means that we must "buy back", or "take advantage" of the time that we are allotted here on this earth. James 4:13-14 and Job 14:1 -2, reminds us that our time on earth is brief. Time passes so quickly. It seems that the older that one grows, the faster time seems to move.

Consider this point when it comes to our efforts in church work. Are we so busy with work, family, and extracurricular activities that we have no time left for the Lord's work? We have so many opportunities for service before us; especially this summer. There are many different types of work in which to involve ourselves. Are allowing ourselves to become so busy that we are not able to participate, or take advantage of these things? If we are going to reach the lost, edify the saved, and restore the erring, then we need all hands on deck. We all must be sure that we are leaving time in our busy days to make phone calls, write a card, or anything else that will be asked of us.

The point is this: what are you doing with your time here on earth? Are you so busy with everyday life that you have left no time for God? If so, it is not too late to change that. Each of us can do a better job of "redeeming the time." If you have changes that need to be made in your life, please do not wait. Remember the words of Paul found in 2 Cor. 6:2: "now is the day of salvation."
