In the early 1970's, Don McClean wrote and recorded a song entitled, "American Pie". The song became an instant hit and has since sold millions of copies over the years. Much speculation followed about what or who McClean was writing about when he wrote,

I can't remember if I cried

When I read about his widowed bride

Something touched me deep inside

The day the music died

In 2015, McClean revealed that the song was partly about the death of Buddy Holly, the young singer tragically killed in a plane crash in 1959 along with several other popular singers. The 8-minute song rambles through a myriad of other topics, many of which still are unexplained.

Another line in the song also caught my attention:

The Father, Son, and the Holy Ghost
