# *Standing in Our Place*

I can remember when I use to help my dad do yard work when I was a child. These are fond memories that I am now enjoying with my children. I am especially mindful of a time when I was about 10 years old and he asked me to help him cut down a tree. I was so excited that he had asked me to help; mostly because I thought he was going to let me use the chainsaw (he didn't).

When it came time to cut the tree down, I had very specific instructions. My dad had a rope tied to the tree, and I held the other end. He placed me in the spot in which he needed me. That was my spot. If the tree was going to fall where he wanted, then I was going to have to stand in my spot and fulfill my responsibility. I can remember being terrified that the tree was going to fall on me, but I knew my dad wouldn't let that happen and things went just as they were supposed to.

In Judges 7, we read of a man by the name of Gideon. He was commanded by God to go and destroy the Midianites. When Gideon issued the call to battle, 32,000 responded. God told him that that was too many. Eventually, the number was reduced all the way down to 300. Many of these were sent home due to fear. However, the 300 were stouthearted! They were assigned places and they accepted those places. They sensed a great deal of responsibility. Though, greatly outnumbered, they trusted in the Lord and were victorious.

Just as Gideon was issued a call, we are called to do the Lord's work today. We are commanded to strengthen the saved and to win souls to the Lord. We all have a place, or a responsibility, in order to accomplish this. Many fail to fulfill their responsibilities due to fear. However, we must trust the Lord and know that we can be successful because of Him (Phil. 4:13). We cannot let fear keep us from standing in our places. Are you standing in your place? Are you fulfilling your responsibilities to the Lord? If we are going to accomplish what the Lord wills, then we must be!!
