True Courage

A few years ago, a prominent CEO of a fast food chain was asked his opinion on gay marriage. This man, without hesitation, proclaimed his belief in the Biblical definition of marriage. Now, I do not agree with most of the things that this man believes in. However, I was in complete agreement for his answer to this question. The courage that it took for this man to answer in this way is admirable. He knew that he was going to become a target, yet he still stood by what the Bible says about marriage.

The more I thought about this situation, the more I began to wonder how many of us have this type of courage. The courage to stand behind the Bible no matter what; and I talking about more than just what the Bible says about marriage. Do we have to courage to stand behind the Bible in all that it teaches? In 1 Pet. 3:15, Peter tells us that we have to “...*be ready to give an answer for the hope that is in us...*” In 1 Thess. 5:21, Paul commands us to “*prove all things and hold fast to that which is good.*” True courage is needed if we are going to fulfill these commands.

It would be good to point out that courage is not belittling, or insulting someone else. Many have the concept that this is what courage is. If you don't do, or say, what I think you should, then I'm courageous if I slander you. Courage is standing in the face opposition and defending the TRUTH. Not out of hate, but out of love. We must remember what Paul told the Christians at Corinth. In 1 Cor. 13:1-3, he reminded them that without love being the motivation, our actions, or teachings, are useless. True courage does not lash out, but calmly, and lovingly, stands behind the truths of the Bible.

It is a great temptation to give into pop culture. We see a progressive attitude being pushed on us from every direction. Yet, God still expects us to uphold His truth. We must remember the words of Jesus in Matt. 10:32-33; “*Every one therefore who shall confess me before men, him will I also confess before my Father who is in heaven. But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father who is in heaven.*”
