Mercy, Peace, and Love

(Jude 2)

The salutation of Jude begins this way: **“Mercy unto you and peace and love be multiplied.”** These blessings were things that the audience of Jude’s letter needed. However, God’s people now need the three blessings of mercy, peace, and love just as they did in the 1st Century. Realizing that we have these three blessings should cause us to rejoice that we are so blessed. It should motivate us to want to share these blessings with others. And it should cause us to renew our determination to be faithful to God.

Mercy. Mercy is a manifestation of pity or sympathy (Vine). God’s mercy is manifested in His willingness to forgive instead of to administer immediate punishment for our sins. *“Grace”* is God giving us what we do not deserve. *“Mercy”* is God not giving us what we do deserve. Eph. 2:4 tells us that God is *“rich in mercy”* due to His *“great love”* for us. Titus 3:5 reveals that God saved us according to His mercy. Through His mercy He provided a Savior and offers man salvation from sin.

Peace. Peace is the tranquility of the inner man or soul of a person. Paul teaches us that peace begins only when one makes peace with God (Rom. 5:1). It is only when we make peace with God that we can have the *“peace of God”* (Phil. 4:6-7). The gospel is the *“gospel of peace”* because it informs us of the way to make peace with God. Peace is not found in drugs, alcohol, or things. It is found through obedience to God’s will!

Love. In a world of hate, greed, and war, we can know the joy of love. God has demonstrated His great love for us (John 3:16; 1 John 4:8-10). Reality Therapy asserts that all people have two fundamental needs: to love and be loved and to feel a sense of worth. God meets both of these fundamental needs. He loved you so much that He sent His Son. He loves you so much that the plan of salvation rest on your shoulders (Mark 16:15-16)!

These blessings can be *“multiplied”* in our lives (Jude 2). The closer we grow to God in obedience, the greater these three blessings become. To enjoy these blessing is truly a joy of life! These blessings belong to those who have obeyed the *“common salvation”* (Jude 3). Why would anyone want to miss out on these three great blessings of God?
