The Plains of Ono

By the time we come to the book of Nehemiah, we find that the Babylonians had destroyed the walls of Jerusalem. Israel had been in captivity for some 70 years. However, Nehemiah had a resolution to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem. The enemies of Israel reacted with *"laughing us to scorn"* (Neh. 2:19), with ridicule (Neh. 4:1-3), and by attacking those who were working to rebuild the wall (Neh. 4:7-8). In this book, we find some great lessons for us today.

I. THE CHALLENGE OF THE WORLD.

When Nehemiah and the Jews were trying to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem, there was an attempt to distract them (Neh. 6:2) Nehemiah responded by saying *that "I am doing a great work, so that I can-not come down: why should the work cease, whilst I leave it, and come down to you?"* (v.3). Nehemiah's great response shows that he was not willing to compromise the work of the Lord for anything. We face the same situation today. The world calls us to compromise on moral and doctrinal issues, but we must not! Paul tells us to not conform to this world (Rom. 12:1-2). James tells us that we cannot be a friend of the world and remain pleasing to God (James 4:4). Why should the work of the Lord stop so that we can please those of the world?

II. THE CALL OF THE RIGHTEOUS.

We, as Christians, have a great work that we must be doing. Jesus tells us that salvation must be preached to the world (Mark 16:15-16). Paul, through inspiration, tells us that the gospel is God's power to save (Rom. 1:16). However, a perverted gospel does not save (Gal. 1:6-9). This means that we cannot compromise on doctrinal issues. We must teach everything that God's word has to say, or carry the consequences (2 John 9). We also have a responsibility to obey the commands of God's word (1 John 2:3-5). This requires a refusal to compromise on moral issues as well. As Christians we are the salt and the light of the world (Matt. 5:13-14). Our actions should glorify God (Matt. 5:16), not bring shame to Him.

The temptation to compromise is ever before us. I pray that we will have the strength and faith of Nehemiah to resist it. Let us always strive to do the will of the Lord.
