Hearing and Heeding God's Word

(Psalm 119:9, 11)

Psalm 119 is the longest chapter in the Bible and it is devoted to a discussion of the importance of God's word. This lesson is important due to the fact that we need to understand the necessity of taking opportunities for Bible study seriously. God's word is powerful in our lives only if we know it! How does God's word work in our lives today?

God's word provides cleansing power for the young. (Psalm 119:9)

America has all types of laws for protecting the physical man. However, what about protection for the mind? In Proverbs 4:23, we are told to "Keep thy heart with all diligence; For out of it are the issues of life." This is especially true of our young people. There are so many efforts made to seduce our young people. So, if we are going to keep them right in life, we must be teaching them God's word (Prov. 22:6). There is a wonderful responsibility for young people (1 John 2:14).

God's word provides protective power for all. (Psalm 119:11)

Sin is a reality. All sin is fundamentally against God. God's word provides protection against sin and the effects of it. When we <u>know</u> God's word, then our homes, hearts and lives will be better protected. Ignorance of the scriptures has led many families to adopt worldly standards as their own. This has resulted in a weakness in their relationship with God and each other. If we want to be successful in life and in our homes, then a knowledge of God's word must be a top priority. Obedience to God's word brings salvation (1 Peter 1:22-25). If we are saved by the word, then we must know the word. How can we know the God of the Bible unless we know God's Bible?
