A Sacrificial Prayer Life
(Acts 4:23-31)
In Acts 3, Peter and John were arrested for healing a crippled man and for preaching the gospel. In Acts 4:23-31, they have been released and are now reunited with fellow Christians and tell them all that has happened. It is significant to point out that their response is to raise their voices together in prayer. Instead of asking for these hardships to be removed, they plead for courage to stand up and be counted for Jesus. Prayer should be an altar of sacrifice that we approach daily. Prayer is to be more than just a laundry list of requests and desires. It is a place where we meet God and surrender our will to His. Acts 4 teaches us how to pour ourselves out more sacrificially. <b>I. Sacrificial Prayer Acknowledges that God is Sovereign. (v. 24)</b>
A. One of the first things that we must sacrifice is our desire to be in B. Sacrificial prayer brings humility and makes us realize that is the one in control.
1. I must remember that His ways are better than my ways! (Isa. 55:8-9)
2. We bring trouble upon ourselves every time we try to take control! (1 Sam. 13:9-13)
C. In prayer, we must our plans, agendas, and dreams to the sovereignty of God. (1 John
5:14) IL Sacrificial Prever Surrondors Itself to the Word of Cod (v. 25-26)
II. Sacrificial Prayer Surrenders Itself to the Word of God. (v. 25-26) A. We often try to separate time in the Word with time in prayer.
1. However, the Bible is clear that the two in a powerful way. (Acts 2:42)
2. As part of that communication, we must allow time for God to speak to us, which He does through His . (Heb. 1:1-2)
B. Sacrificial prayer involves surrendering in quietness to the voice and direction of God that we hear through His word. (Matt. 26:39-42)
III. Sacrificial Prayer Makes Room for God to Work. (v. 27-28, 30)
A. The Christians in Acts 4 laid out their concerns before God, and then they took a step
1. They were leaving room for God to work in them and in the situation.
2. So many times we ask God to our plan of action, rather waiting and making room for His will to be done.
B. God wants us to place our burdens and cares upon Him. (Matt. 11:28-30; 1 Pet. 5:6-7)
IV. Sacrificial Prayer Asks for Courage to Continue in Sacrifice. (v. 29)
A. The heart of their request lied in their desire to have the to continue preaching Jesus.
B. If sacrifice wasn't, or it wouldn't be sacrifice! (Mark 12:42-44; 2 Cor. 9:6-8)
1. Do we have the courage necessary to sacrifice offer something valuable to the One who is beyond val-
