Give Me The Bible

(Hosea 4:6)

A growing problem in our society is one of Bible illiteracy. "Americans revere the Bible, but, by and large, they don't read it. And because they don't read it, they have become a nation of biblical illiterates." (George Gallup and Jim Castelli). Bible illiteracy can wreak havoc in our personal lives and in the church. It is because of the dangers of Bible illiteracy that we must be committed to study.

I. THE DANGERS OF BIBLICAL ILLITERACY.

- A. This is something that will affect us personally.
 - 1. God's people have always been destroyed by a lack of knowledge. (Hosea 4:1, 6)
 - 2. Without knowledge of God's Word, a person does not have:
 - a. Any direction or guidance in life. (Psalm 119:105)
 - b. True joy or peace in life. (Psalm 119:111, 165)
- B. Look at the effect that it has on the church.
 - 1. Who will be the teachers if this problem is not corrected? (Heb. 5:12-14)
 - 2. How will we know what is right, or wrong? (Eph. 4:13-14)

II. THE ANTIDOTE FOR BIBLICAL ILLITERACY.

- A. Daily devotional bible reading in the home.
 - 1. A truly blessed person meditates upon the word of God daily! (Psalm 1:1-3; 119:97-98)
 - 2. As busy as our days have become, this has become a difficult thing to make time for.
- B. Frequent in-depth bible study with fellow Christians.
 - 1. As Christians, we realize the value of mutual edification. (Heb. 3:12-14; 10:24-25)
 - 2. One of the reasons that we assemble together is so that we can study together.

I need to know what God wants of me, and to be able to share that message with those around me. I cannot do either of those if I am do not know what God's word teaches. Let us not be satisfied with just having Bibles in our possession. Let's open them and know them!
