## Revival

We have been commanded to spread the borders of the Lord's Kingdom (Mark 16:15-16). However, we will never be able to accomplish this important task if our light is not burning. I can never evangelize as I should if my fire for the Lord is going out. Many times, there is a need for revival before a congregation can grow. How does a congregation revive itself in order to seek and save the lost?

#### 1. Keep hungering for the word of God. (Neh. 8:1-5, 18)

Nehemiah had been tasked with rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem. He was able to finish this task in 52 days! Yet, after the wall was rebuilt, we find that the people listened to God's word from early in the morning until midday. They were not concerned about time, or comfort. They were only interested in hearing God's word. How we feel towards the word of God is great indicator in regards to our spiritual strength. If we find ourselves more concerned with what time it is, instead of what God's word says, we are in need of a revival.

#### 2. Keep honoring God with passionate worship. (Neh. 8:6; 9:4-6)

It is not enough to just "show up" to worship services. If my worship is going to be pleasing to God, then it must be passionate, or in spirit (John 4:24). It is easy to forget that we are not the audience of worship; God is. He is to be the focal point of everything that we do when we assemble. Is He the focus of our worship? If not, then we are in need of a revival!

#### 3. Humble ourselves through honest confession. (Neh. 8:9; 9:1-3, 33)

Often times, it takes us taking an honest look at ourselves before we can be useful to the Lord. However, knowing that we need to make changes is useless, unless we are going to do something about it. John tells us that if will honestly confess our shortcomings to God, He will forgive us (1 John 1:9). Honest confession to God helps us to remember our dependency upon Him. It helps to keep us closer to Him. Many times, the honest confession is what "stokes" up the flame within our hearts!
