Rewards of Shining 1 Peter 1:3-4

Living a life that shines is a difficult task. We are constantly feeling pressure to conform to the world around us instead of living reverent, holy lives (Rom. 12:1-2). There are the temptations that we must resist on a regular basis (1 Pet. 2:11). Due to this difficulty, many come up with excuses for their lack of shining. To overcome these excuses, we need to remind ourselves of the reward of shining.
