The Sacrificial Servant

(Mark 10:45)

For the month of November, our topic will be “*rise up and serve.*” Service is an essential part of Christianity. But, it is so easy for the attitudes of the world to influence us. When we come to Mark 10, we see that even the apostles struggled with wanting power and prominence. Jesus reminded them, that the only way to greatness was through service! The greatest example that we have of service is that of the Lord Jesus Christ.

1. Jesus Came to Serve. (Mark 10:45)
