How Strong is Your Faith?

This is a question that would offend many. However, this is a question that we must ask ourselves and that we must answer honestly. We must face temptation every day. This means that we have to make decisions every day to do what is right or to sin. The strength of our faith is the deciding factor in making these choices. If my faith is as strong as it needs to be, then I will do what God would have me to do. If I am not as strong as I should be, then I will give into whatever temptation that I am facing. In this article, I want us to look at three areas in which many struggle when it comes to their faith.

Faith under peer-pressure. The truth of the matter is that our friends can talk us into about anything. Most of us can think of an example of this without having to try hard. Paul warns us of peer-pressure (1 Cor. 15:33). There are many who struggle with a weak faith due to peer-pressure. What is the best way to overcome negative peer-pressure? Surround ourselves with those who are going to pull us up, not drag us down. We need to be sure that we are consciously making the decision to strengthen our faith when it comes to peer-pressure.

Telling the one's we love the truth. This is an extremely difficult thing to do. The world tells us that if we really love someone, then we will overlook their flaws and act like that whatever they want to do is ok. The Bible tells us the exact opposite. In Mark 10:17-22, Jesus is having a conversation with a certain young man. This passage tells us that Jesus, loving this young man, told him what he needed to hear. Jesus knew what was going to happen, however, it was the truth. We have to make the decision that we will tell the people that we love the truth, no matter how hard it is. Paul, in 1 Cor. 13, tells us that true love does not rejoice in iniquity.

Faith to completely trust God. This may seem like an odd thing to say. How can a person be a Christian, yet lack complete faith in God? Well, the answer is pretty simple. It is human nature to want to know how everything is going to turn out. We want to be able to read the back of the book first, so that we can know how the story is going to turn out. However, life does not work that way. James 4:14 tells us that we do not know what tomorrow holds and that scares us. The result is that we have a really difficult time truly believing that God will work out everything for our good (Rom. 8:28). We may not know what tomorrow holds, but we can know that we serve an Almighty God who does!

May we work diligently to strengthen ourselves in these three areas. The more temptations we overcome the stronger our faith grows. God has given us everything that we need in order to overcome temptation. Let us be sure that we are utilizing His gifts!
