Something To Think About

- A Christian woman was overheard saying to another Christian woman, *"When we get to Heaven, I hope your mansion is next to mine!"*. What a beautiful thought. Can you say that about *all* of your Christian brethren? If not, now is the time to do something about it.
- David, the King, was called a "man after God's own heart"; yet he sinned. David was forgiven because he repented of his sin. We, too, can gain the forgiveness of God for our sins; no matter how dreadful. We simply must ask.
- Scripture teaches that God will judge all murderers, rapists, thieves, liars, adulterers, etc. He will even judge our words and our thoughts. *On judgement day, will you be found guilty or innocent of breaking His Law?* Perhaps you think that God is good (and He is!) and will therefore overlook your sins. But it is His goodness that will ensure that murderers, rapists, thieves, liars, adulterers, etc. receive justice. He would be a corrupt judge if He turned a blind eye to injustice!
- We have the inexpressible privilege of sharing. *"We have this treasure in earthen vessels"* (2 Cor. 4:7). *"We are ambassadors therefore on behalf of Christ, as though God were entreating by us"* (2 Cor. 5:20). To share the glorious Good News of salvation in Christ, and positive thoughts in a world of negativity.
