Answering the Call

(1 Samuel 16)

In 1 Samuel 16, David is called to be king over Israel. Israel had been ruled by judges for about 330 years. Then, they demanded a king and Saul was anointed as the first king. Saul's reign began with promise but ended in faithlessness (1 Sam. 16:14). When we read the story of David's calling, we see several applications for Christians today. The greatest of those applications is the need to answer God's call. To put it another, the need for a willing heart.
