Reminders about Temptation

(1 Corinthians 10:12-13)

Every one of us has to deal with the problem of temptation. This problem can be very frustrating. There are many times where we feel that the temptations that we are facing may be too much for us to handle. Even though we may “feel” that way, Paul gives us some information that we need to remind ourselves of when it comes to temptation. If we hold to these reminders, we will find that there is not a temptation out there that we cannot overcome!

Temptation is common. (1 Cor. 10:13)

There is not a temptation that we will face that is unique to us. Enticements to sin are categorized under three headings according to 1 John 2:15-17. They are the “lust of the flesh”, “the lust of the eyes”, and “the pride of life”. We see that Eve and Christ were both tempted according to these three avenues. The difference was not in the type of temptations, but in the reaction to it. Eve gave into the temptations, while Christ overcame it. It should be a great source of encouragement to know that we are not alone when it comes to being tempted. We have brothers and sisters in Christ that are going through the same things! This is another reason we need to build up one another.

Temptation is controlled. (1 Cor. 10:13)

God is faithful, especially in the face of temptation. God would not allow Satan to place more on Job than he could bear (Job 1:12; 2:6). According the world, Job lost everything, yet he was able to endure it. How? Job realized that God was still in control and that He was still faithful (Job 1:21). Because of this, Job remained faithful to God (Job 1:22). God will not allow us to be tempted above our means to resist as long as: we are faithful children walking with Him (1 John 1:7); as long as we are putting His kingdom and righteousness first (Matt. 6:33); and as long as we are studying His word and continuing steadfastly in prayer (Act. 2:42; 1 Thess. 5:17).

Temptation is conquerable. (1 Cor. 10:13)

Being tempted is not the sin! Sin comes when we give into the temptation and break a precept of God’s law (1 John 3:4). The devil can be resisted (James 4:7). The point of 1 Cor. 10:13 is to assure us that God wants us to overcome temptation. God will provide the means to escape, but we must be looking for the escape route and then we must **use it!** Just because we must face temptation does not mean that we must give into it!

Great wisdom is expressed in this passage of scripture. The inspired apostle issues the warning that there is a grave danger of falling and losing our salvation. However, he closes with the promise that God has given us powerful means of standing fast in the faith (1 Cor. 15:58). May this be a great comfort to us as we struggle to walk faithfully each day.
