Faith to Overcome the World

(Hebrews 11:24-26)

Saving faith is a faith that overcomes the world (1 John 5:4-5). Moses is someone who demonstrated a faith to overcome the world. By faith, Moses refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter (Heb. 11:24-26). By faith, Moses overcame the pressures to conform and chose to suffer as one of God's people. If we are going to have a faith that pleases God, like Moses, then we must have a faith that overcomes the world.

1. A Faith that Overcomes the World has the Right Attitude Toward the World.

- A. As Christians, we are _____ "out of the world." (Col. 1:13; 2 Tim. 2:19)
 - 1. In fact, this is exactly what the word "church" means!
 - 2. This means that we are not to _____ like the world. (1Pet. 1:15-16)
- B. John told us to "not love the world." (1 John 2:15-17)
 - 1. Notice that John tells us that the things of the world "_____ away." (v. 17)
 - 2. Moses realized that the things that this world has to offer, along with the desire for those things, are temporary.
- C. James tells us to keep ourselves "unspotted" from the world. (Jam. 1:27)
 - 1. This is part of "_____" religion.
 - 2. God isn't pleased when we return to the dirt.
- D. Paul urges us to not be "conformed" to the world. (Rom. 12:2)

2. A Faith that Overcomes the World is Prepared for People to Not Like Us.

- A. Notice that due to his faith, Moses suffered ill-treatment. (Heb. 11:25)
- B. Jesus told His disciples that they would be _____ without a cause. (John 17:14)
 - 1. Living a life of faith will cause us to "stand out." (Matt. 5:14-16)
 - 2. Living a life of faith will cause people to think that we are _____, or weird. (1 Pet. 4:4)

3. A Faith that Overcomes the World Treats Those of the World Properly.

- A. Possess a humility that causes you to be _____ with all types of people. (Phil. 2:3)
 - 1. Warmness draws people, coldness repels them.
 - 2. We can spend time with people without getting down on their level of sin. (Matt. 9:11)
- B. We must be _____. (Phil. 2:4)
- C. We need to follow the Golden Rule. (Matt. 7:12)
