## Complete In Christ

Man has many needs. We spend our lives searching for the things that will fulfill all the needs that we have. Many tend to look in the wrong places to try to fulfill those needs. However, there is only one place that we need to look and that is in Christ Jesus. The book of Colossians reveals to us that Christ is able to fulfill all the spiritual needs of man. So, what are the basic needs supplied by Christ?

#### Wisdom (Colossians 2:3).

We can have knowledge of Christ's will (Col. 1:9; 3:16). Christianity appeals to man's intellect, not just emotion. The first step in obeying the will of Christ is to hear it and then to understand it (Rom. 10:17). Christ has made sure to give us all the information that we need to know so that we can be "thoroughly furnished" (2 Tim. 3:16).

#### Redemption (Colossians 1:14).

The word redemption has its roots in the Old Testament and is based on a word which spoke of the emancipation of the Israelites from Egyptian bondage. The redemption from our sins is only made possible through the blood of Christ (1 Peter 1:18-19). We see that redemption is not found in anyone other than Christ Himself (Col. 1:14)

#### Forgiveness (Colossians 1:14)

Not only does a person have redemption in Christ, but also the forgiveness of sins. This is to be released from the debt owed to God, the debt of God's righteous judgment. In Acts 8, we see that forgiven people are happy people. Romans 5:6-8 reminds of the incredible debt that the love of God freed us from.

#### Self-esteem (Colossians 3:12).

This verse calls us the "elect of God". This shows that all people in Christ are people of worth! It is easy to allow ourselves to feel unimportant, or useless. However, God does not think so. When a person in Christ is feeling down and depressed, this person should read John 3:16 to remind themselves of the great price that God paid for them.

Ephesians 1:3 tells us that all spiritual blessings are found in Christ. There are many other blessings found in Christ, but we simply touched on a few. Why would anyone not want to be in Christ? It is only in Christ that a person can truly be complete. How does one get into Christ? Galatians 3:27 tells us that we get into Christ through baptism. We must hear His word (Rom. 10:17), believe it (Joh. 8:24), repent (Luke 13:3), confess (Rom. 10:10), be baptized (Acts 2:28), and to live faithfully to Him the rest of our days (Col. 3). If you are not in Christ, I plead with you to do so. If you have gotten out of Christ, I urge you to return.
