Of First Importance: Sanctification

When a person becomes a Christian, the work of God is just beginning. The goal is not merely to secure forgiveness, but to transform saved people into the image of God's Son. However, Satan will do everything in his power to resist the removal of sin and retake lost ground. It is no wonder that the Bible describes the Christian life as a holy war that must be waged constantly. (2 Cor. 10:3-6)

10:3-6) 1. Sanctification is a Process. A. The struggle against sin is 1. The immediate break with sin occurs in conversion, but the commitment to honor that break never ceases. 2. Every day, Christians must their love for God and resist the temptation that puts their love to the test. (Rom. 12:1-2) B. There are 3 distinct ways to view the work of sanctification. : When a person becomes a child of God, he experiences a change of status or relationship. (Rom. 5:10) 2. A process: The heart is changed, and the will is committed to honoring the heart's intent. (1 John 3:9) : A renewed heart results in a reformed life. 2. The Responsibility of Sanctification. A. In its primary sense, sanctification is the work of (1 Thess. 5:23) 1. In addition to the Father's work, Jesus is involved in sanctification through the giving of His life. (Eph. 5:25-26) 2. The Holy Spirit is also involved in sanctification by helping us our thoughts, words, and deeds to God's will through the scriptures. (1 Cor. 6:11) B. However, sanctification is also the responsibility of the Christian. 3. The Resources for Sanctification. A. We are sanctified by B. Jesus told Paul that faith in Him was the key to sanctification. (Acts 26:18) 1. Spiritual life spontaneously generate any more than physical life.

2. Sanctification is the development of a purer, more fervent faith in Christ through the power of God's word.
