Certainty Despite Uncertainty

(1 Peter 1:6-12)

Peter wrote to a scattered church in Asia that would have been completely justified in having a collective anxiety attack. Despite this, Peter reminds his readers to rejoice even though they are being distressed by various trials (1 Pet. 1:6-7). Peter wanted them to know that they could rejoice because there is certainty in the Christian life. Often times, the reason that we become hopeless is due to the fact that we forget what we have.
