Motivation for a Good Man to do Good (3 John)

The apostle John was concerned about the physical well-being of Gaius (3 John 2). Yet, despite what Gaius' health problems were, they did not keep him from serving God. This is unlike some who allow minor problems to be an excuse for unfaithful service to God. If we are going to do good, then we need motivation. Motivation in doing good can be a real problem (Jam. 4:17). Knowing what to do is not motivation in itself. There are additional factors that must be active in one's life.

The influence of truth (3 John 4). Gaius was not embarrassed of the truth. He was known for "*walking in truth*" (3 John 3). This means that Gaius applied the truth to his life. This should prove to us that there is an absolute truth (1 John 2:3-5)! John's greatest joy was not that Gaius was popular, or that he was successful in business, but that Gaius "*walked*" in the truth. Just as food gives the physical body energy, the truth gives the soul energy to do good.

The inner working of love (3 John 6). Gaius had balance in his life. Truth without love is harsh and judgmental. Love without truth is weak and compromising. Gaius was not at either extreme. Paul shows us the necessity of serving God in love (1 Cor. 13). The reason that love is so important is that without love our religion is useless. Love must be a motivation behind our words and actions!

An ideal for His life (3 John 6). Gaius desired to live a life that was worthy of God! This should be the ideal, and motivation, for all of our lives. We should want to live lives that would be pleasing to God. Just think of the type of people that we would be if this was constantly on the forefront of our minds! Think of how much better off our country would be if our leaders had this mindset! How much better would our homes be? What a great motivation to do good.

Gaius was a good man known for doing good. God's truth was a powerful force in his life. He had learned to love God's people. And, he had an ideal to challenge him. Let us follow the example of this good man!
